Positions of Responsibility

For all positions:

- ✓ Attend troop and leadership meetings as described below.
- ✓ Sets a good example.
- Enthusiastically and correctly wears the Scout uniform
- ✓ Lives by the Scout Oath and Law.
- ✓ Shows Scout spirit.
- ✓ Delegate responsibilities as required.

Attendance

- ✓ 75% of weekly meetings means you can miss about one per month.
- ✓ 80% of monthly leadership meetings means you can miss one during a six-month term.
- ✓ On time (early as appropriate).
- ✓ Stay until the end (through cleanup as appropriate).

Senior Patrol Leader

- > Must have reached Star rank
- ✓ Attend most (75%+) of weekly meetings.
- ✓ Attend most (80%+) of PLC meetings.
- ✓ Lead troop meeting.
- ✓ Lead monthly PLC meeting.
- ✓ Appoint patrol leadership when PL and APL are absent.
- Ensure that PL plans and executes meeting program.
- ✓ Lead campout planning.
- ✓ At campouts, take overall leadership, ensuring that PLs lead their patrols.

Assistant Senior Patrol Leader

- > Must have reached Star rank
- ✓ As for SPL, when SPL is absent or requires assistance.

Patrol Leader

- ➤ Must have reached First Class rank
- ✓ Attend most (75%+) of weekly meetings
- ✓ Attend most (80%+) of PLC meetings.
- ✓ Supervise patrol at meetings, notably setup and tear-down.
- ✓ Ensure somebody arrives EARLY for setup.
- ✓ Lead patrol meetings.
- ✓ Plan and execute meeting program for those months the patrol is responsible for.
- ✓ Lead patrol planning for campouts.
- ✓ At campouts, lead patrol in setup, tear-down, and other activities.

Assistant Patrol Leader

- ➤ Must have reached First Class rank
- ✓ As for PL, when PL is absent or requires assistance.
- > APL does not count towards Star, Life, or Eagle requirements.

Venture Patrol Leader

➤ N/A for 92

Troop Guide

- ✓ Supervise and mentor pre-First-Class Scouts.
- ✓ Teach basic Scout skills.

Order of the Arrow Troop Representative

- ✓ Participate in one OA event per 6-month term
- ✓ Attends most (80%+) OA meetings

Den Chief

- ✓ Attend most (75%+) den meetings.
- ✓ Attend most (80%+) pack meetings.
- ✓ Assist Cubmaster as required.
- ✓ Helps lead den meetings.

Scribe

- ✓ Attend most (75%+) of weekly meetings.
- ✓ Attend most (80%+) of PLC meetings.
- ✓ Record minutes of PLC meetings, including attendance.
- ✓ Record troop meeting attendance
- ✓ Record troop event attendance

Librarian

- ✓ Holds troop library:
 - MB booklets
 - o SPL Handbook
 - PL Handbook
- ✓ Bring library to first meeting of the month for borrowing.
- ✓ Tracks items, follows up on late returns.

Historian

- ✓ Holds troop trophies and other awards.
- ✓ Collects photos, news articles, et cetera.
- ✓ Maintains a scrapbook.
- ✓ Coordinates with Webmaster to post photos online.

Quartermaster

- ✓ Hold troop flags and banners and bring them to meetings EARLY.
 - Missing flags at no more than two meetings per term.
- ✓ Bring flags to other events as required.
 - ➤ No (zero) missing flags at other events.
- Quarterly inventory of equipment, checking for missing equipment and equipment that must be replaced.
 - Three inventories one right after start of term with the previous QM, one mid-term, one right after end of term with the new QM.

Bugler

- ✓ Play Taps at meetings and on campouts, and other calls as appropriate.
- Bugler does not count towards Eagle requirements

Junior Assistant Scoutmaster

✓ Assist Scoutmasters as required.

Chaplain's Aide

- > Must hold one religious award
- ✓ Leads troop in prayer at meeting close
- ✓ Leads troop in prayer at end of campouts
- ✓ Help another Scout earn a religious award during term.

Instructor

- ✓ Conduct one class per quarter in an appropriate subject area.
- ✓ Give basic Scout skill instruction one-on-one as required.

Troop Webmaster

- ✓ Helps run troop web site.
- ✓ Works with historian to post photos and reports.

Leave No Trace Trainer

- ➤ Requires official 16-hour LNT Trainer course
- ✓ Conduct one class per term
- ✓ Lead responsible patrol in cleaning troop meeting area after meetings.
- ✓ Lead troop in cleaning campsites.
