Troop 92 offers an electronic mailing list for troop-related communication between the Scouts. Mailing list traffic can be directed to a Scout's existing e-mail account, or the troop can provide an e-mail account.

Monitoring

E-mail traffic on the troop's Scout mailing list will be monitored by two adults – one uniformed leader selected by the Scoutmaster and one parent selected by the Troop Committee chair. In addition, all e-mail traffic on the mailing list will be archived.

Security

Only members of the mailing list will be able to send to the list; all other messages will be held for manual approval by the list maintainer. The e-mail address of anybody sending to the mailing list will be visible to all members of the mailing list. The mailing list archive will be visible only to members.

Although reasonable precautions will be taken in the handling of this mailing list, perfect security is neither possible nor practical. Small risks will remain, including the possibilities that an outsider will be able to read current and archived communications, discover Scouts' e-mail addresses, and send messages to the mailing list.

Rules

Scouts must at all times conduct themselves according to the Scout Oath and Law. Abuse will not be tolerated, and may result in restrictions in the use of the mailing list. Scouts must keep any passwords secret and not share them with others.
